**(Red)** Castillo de Clavijo Rioja Crianza, Spain  
Aged for 12 to 18 months in American and French oak casks, it shows bright red berry fruit balanced with vanilla and spice to add richness and body. The Castillo Clavijo range is produced by Bodegas Criadores de Rioja, a Bodegas which typifies twenty-first century Rioja in its careful balancing of tradition and innovation.

## **(Red)** Tilia Malbec, Argentina

Plum, blackberry and dark chocolate flavours with a hint of pepper and spice are all evident on the nose and palate. Part of the Catena group of wineries Tilia wines are made with a combination of fruit sourced from the traditional eastern sub-region of Mendoza.

## **(White)** Tokomaru Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand

New Zealand is famous for its Sauvignon Blanc and this is a great example of why. It has intense, crisp green fruit and aromas along with intense tropical passion fruit notes. It's very fruity and has an intense smell but a fairly light body.

# HOUSE RANGE



## (Red) Old Press Shiraz, Australia

Great Aussie red, packed full of peppery berries. The old press harks back to the beginnings of Australian wine production when settlers planted vines they bought with them from Europe. The wines they produced, like the Old Press wines, were fruity, uncomplicated and easy to drink.

## (White) Terre Forte Trebbiano Chardonnay, Italy

An easy drinking fresh white wine, in which the Trebbiano gives the freshness, the Chardonnay gives the fruit. The good people at Terre Forti not only work tirelessly in the vineyard in the pursuit of creating fantastic wines, they have a real focus on becoming environmentally sustainable.

## (Rosé) Finca Valero Garnacha Rosado, Spain

**(Red)** La Serre Cabernet Sauvignon, France  
Black fruits and cassis from the Deep South (of France). La Serre has a history stretching back two decades to when it was one of the pioneers of varietal wines and labels from the South of France in the UK market.

**(Red)** Cosecha Tarapaca Carmenere, Chile  
Intense fresh fruity aromas of blackberries and plums. Soft toasted notes mixed with sweet vanilla and a spicy green pepper finish. Vina Tarapaca was established in 1874 in the foothills of the Andes. Their vineyards are in one of Chile's traditional wine growing regions, the Maipo Valley.

**(White)** The Spee'Wah Sauvignon Blanc / Semillon, Australia  
Fantastic Semillon component for structure and grassy notes from the early harvest Sauvignon. Elizabeth Richardson is the winemaker behind the label and she has cherry picked parcels of outstanding fruit to make these wines and the quality shines through as soon as the bottles are opened.

**(White)** La Maglia Rosa Pinot Grigio, Italy
